Eligibility Requirements

To apply, a student must be:

- Resident of Dover, NH
- A graduating high school senior
- Pursuing a career in law enforcement or related field
- In good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)

Additionally, a student must plan to enroll full-time, in a four-year degree program, at a US accredited college or university.

Ideal Candidate

An ideal candidate will have:

- An outstanding academic record in high school
- Demonstrated leadership ability (e.g., as shown through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities)
- Exceptional personal success skills (e.g., emotional maturity, motivation, perseverance etc.)

Timeline

Online application opens on January 1, 2025 and closes on April 12, 2025. The scholarship winner(s) will be selected in May 2025 before graduation.

Funding

Selected Scholars will receive funding in the amount of \$1,500 to put towards a higher education at a University or College.
